Tiers

Tier 1 exposure sites

Anyone who has visited a Tier 1 exposure site during the times listed must immediately isolate, get a coronavirus (COVID-19) test, and quarantine for 14 days from the date of exposure.

Tier 2 exposure sites

Anyone who has visited a Tier 2 exposure site during times listed should urgently get a test and isolate until they receive a negative result.

Tier 3 exposure sites

Anyone who has visited a Tier 3 exposure site during times listed should monitor for symptoms - If symptoms develop, immediately get tested and isolate until you receive a negative result.

**Remember to bring along fitted face masks when you leave home, and must be worn on Public Transport (includes share ride), by visitors to a hospital or at a care facility, on flights and at airport. Clean your hands thoroughly with water and soap or alcohol-based hand rub before and after every contact with the mask!

**Stay vigilant and safe by maintaining good hand hygiene, coughing and sneezing into your elbow, keeping at least 1.5 metres from others and staying home if you feel unwell.
