## **\*\*限制放寬\*\***

維州州長安德魯斯今天宣布由今晚**7月27日晚上11:59分(星期二)**起，限制有以下的更改：

### **離家外出、訪客及聚會**

1. 解除離家外出及 5 公里的限制，市區及郊區可如常出入。
2. 室內及室外均須繼續配戴口罩。
3. 不允許家中接待訪客聚會。
4. 允許室外公共地方聚會，人數上限 10 人。
5. 能在家工作繼續，辦公室則允許最多同時有百分之二十五員工，或最多 10 人(如總人數不多於 40 人)，保持每人 4 平方米密度。

### **教育及幼兒照顧**

1. 幼兒照顧中心全面開放，中小學開放及恢復面授課程，12 歲以上須配戴口罩。高等教育培訓如能在家進行則需繼續。

### **儀式及宗教聚會**

1. 室內上限 100 人，室外上限 300 人，保持每人 4 平方米密度。場所少於 100 平方米人數上限最多 25 人。
2. 場所需要登記所有出入人士。

### **喪葬或結婚儀式**

1. 不論室外或室內，總人數上限 50 人。
2. 場所需要登記所有出入人士。

### **運動及遊樂場館**

1. 室內上限 100 人，室外上限 300 人，保持每人 4 平方米密度。
2. 場所需要登記所有出入人士。
3. 公共體育訓練及競賽活動可恢復如常進行，保持每人 4 平方米密度。

### **休閒娛樂設施及場所**

1. (固定坐位)室內人數上限 **100** 人，群組上限 **10** 人一組，保持每人 **4** 平方米密度。
2. (固定坐位)室外人收上限 **300** 人，群組上限 **10** 人一組，保持每人 **4** 平方米密度。
3. (不設坐位)室內人數上限 **100** 人，群組上限 **10** 人一組，保持每人 **4** 平方米密度。
4. (不設坐位)室外人收上限 **300** 人，群組上限 **10** 人一組，保持每人 **4** 平方米密度。
5. 場所需要登記所有出入人士。

## 商業設施及會議中心

1. (固定坐位)室內人數上限 **100** 人，群組上限 **10** 人一組，保持每人 **4** 平方米密度。
2. (固定坐位)室外人收上限 **300** 人，群組上限 **10** 人一組，保持每人 **4** 平方米密度。
3. (不設坐位)室內人數上限 **100** 人，群組上限 **10** 人一組，保持每人 **4** 平方米密度。
4. (不設坐位)室外人收上限 **300** 人，群組上限 **10** 人一組，保持每人 **4** 平方米密度。
5. 場所需要登記所有出入人士。

## 一般零售及服務行業

1. 所有零售恢復全面開放，保持每人 **4** 平方米密度及需要登記所有出入人士。
2. 理髮、美容及個人護理服務可重開，服務期間可除下口罩進行。保持每人 **4** 平方米密度及需要登記所有出入人士，人數上限 **25** 人。
3. 飲食場所室只開放設坐位空間，人數上限 **100** 人，群組上限 **10** 人一組，保持每人 **4** 平方米密度。場所少於 **100** 平方米人數上限最多 **25** 人，所有桌上必須貼上登記二維碼。

## 護理院舍及醫院

1. 只在特定情況下才能進行，詳情留意個別院舍及醫院指引。

## CHANGES TO RESTRICTIONS FROM 11.59PM TUESDAY 27 JULY

Note: Cleaning, signage, record keeping, and other COVIDSafe requirements continue to apply for all venues and facilities with onsite operations as per Workplace Directions. The Density Quotient (DQ) applies to all venues and spaces that are accessible to the public (and in closed workplaces, to shared spaces such as lunchrooms).

	State-wide changes
<b>Social gatherings, visitors and leaving home</b>	<p><b>Stay at home requirement:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>No stay at home requirement.</li> <li>Removal of 5km travel limit.</li> </ul> <p><b>Intrastate travel limit:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Movement between metropolitan Melbourne and regional Victoria is unrestricted.</li> <li>Travel to regional Victorian Alpine Resorts permitted provided visitors and workers have had a negative COVID test within the previous 72 hours. Children under 12 years not included. Must be able to show evidence of a negative test as condition of entry into ski field.</li> </ul> <p><b>Face coverings:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Must be carried at all times.</li> <li>Must be worn indoors and outdoors except if at home or if an exception applies.</li> </ul> <p><b>Private gatherings in the home:</b> Not permitted. Intimate partner visits/single bubble permitted.</p> <p><b>Public gatherings:</b> Permitted for up to 10 people.</p> <p><b>Work:</b> If you can work from home, you must work from home. Office work – 25 per cent return or up to 10 people if total workplace is 40 or less, density quotient of 1 person per 4 sqm applies.</p>
<b>Education and childcare</b>	<p><b>Early learning centres, childcare, family day care:</b> Open.</p> <p><b>Schools:</b> Open.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Density quotient of 1 person per 4 sqm applies in non-student areas. Face mask requirements apply to everyone 12 years and over.</li> </ul> <p><b>Higher education and training:</b> If you can study from home, you should continue to study from home.</p>
<b>Ceremonies and Religious Gatherings</b>	<p><b>Religious gatherings and ceremonies:</b> Permitted for up to 100 people indoors and up to 300 people outdoors.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Density quotient of 1 person per 4 sqm applies.</li> <li>A venue smaller than 100sqm can have up to 25 people per venue before density quotient applies.</li> <li>COVID Check-in Marshals must ensure attendees check-in.</li> </ul>
<b>Funerals</b>	<p><b>Funerals (indoor and outdoor):</b> Permitted with 50 people (and those necessary to conduct the funeral). Children under 12 months old are not counted towards this cap. COVID Check-in Marshals must ensure attendees check-in.</p>
<b>Weddings</b>	<p><b>Weddings (indoor and outdoor):</b> Permitted with no more than 50 people (including the two persons being married and two witnesses. The celebrant and photographer are not included in the cap). COVID Check-in Marshals must ensure attendees check-in. Dancefloors not permitted.</p>

COVID Check-in Marshals must ensure attendees check-in</li> <li>Group limit of 10 people</li> </ul> <p><b>Community sport:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Open for all ages, training and competition. Density quotient of 1 person per 4sqm applies</li> <li>Limited to minimum number of people required to participate in and facilitate the activity (i.e. players, coaches)</li> </ul> <p>Spectators not allowed (excludes people necessary for events such as teachers, instructors, trainers, coaches, umpires, carers, parents and guardians).</p>
<b>Community facilities</b>	<p><b>Community facilities:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Open with a density quotient of 1 person per 4sqm</li> <li>Maximum 100 people per indoor space and 300 people per outdoor space. Maximum group size: 10 people</li> <li>COVID Check-in Marshals must ensure attendees check-in</li> </ul>
<b>Creative Studios</b>	<p><b>Creative studios:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Open. A maximum patron cap of 100 people indoors and 300 people outdoors</li> <li>Group limit of 10 people. Density quotient of 1 person per 4sqm applies</li> <li>COVID Check-in Marshals must ensure attendees check-in</li> </ul>
<b>Entertainment and Leisure</b>	<p><b>Indoor fixed seated entertainment:</b> Open up to a maximum of 100 people per space. Group limit of 10 people. Density quotient of 1 person per 4 sqm applies in non-seated areas. COVID Check-in Marshals must ensure attendees check-in.</p> <p><b>Outdoor fixed seated entertainment:</b> Open up to a maximum of 300 people per outdoor space. Group limit of 10 people. Density quotient of 1 person per 4sqm applies in non-seated areas. COVID Check-in Marshals must ensure attendees check-in.</p> <p><b>Indoor non-seated entertainment venues:</b> Open to a maximum of 100 people per space. Group limit of 10 people. Density quotient of 1 person per 4sqm applies. COVID Check-in Marshals must ensure attendees check-in.</p> <p><b>Outdoor non-seated venues:</b> Open to a maximum of 300 people per space. Density quotient of 1 person per 4sqm applies. Group limit of 10 people. 	<b>Retail betting venues:</b> Open to a maximum of 100 people per venue. Density quotient of 1 person per 4sqm applies. COVID Check-in Marshals must ensure attendees check-in.
	<b>Electronic gaming:</b> Open to a maximum of 100 people per venue. Density quotient of 1 person per 4sqm applies. Every second machine closed or 1.5m between machines. COVID Check-in Marshals must ensure attendees check-in.
	<b>Karaoke and Nightclubs:</b> Open for seated service, to a maximum of 100 people per venue, subject to density quotient of 1 person per 4sqm. Group limit of 10 people. Dancefloors not permitted. COVID Check-in Marshals must ensure attendees check-in
<b>Business function facilities and conference centres</b>	<b>Indoor fixed function facilities:</b> Open up to a maximum of 100 people per space. Density quotient of 1 person per 4 sqm applies in non-seated areas. COVID Check-in Marshals must ensure attendees check-in.
	<b>Outdoor fixed seated function facilities:</b> Open up to a maximum of 300 people per outdoor space. Density quotient of 1 person per 4sqm applies in non-seated areas. COVID Check-in Marshals must ensure attendees check-in.
	<b>Indoor non-seated function facilities:</b> Open to a maximum of 100 people per space. Density quotient of 1 person per 4sqm applies. COVID Check-in Marshals must ensure attendees check-in.
	<b>Outdoor non-seated function facilities:</b> Open to a maximum of 300 people per space. Density quotient of 1 person per 4sqm applies. COVID Check-in Marshals must ensure attendees check-in.
<b>General retail</b>	<b>All retail:</b> Open. Density quotient of 1 person per 4sqm applies. Check-in required. A venue smaller than 100sqm can have up to 25 people per venue before density quotient applies.
	<b>Auction houses:</b> A maximum patron cap of 100 people per venue. COVID Check-in Marshals must ensure attendees check-in.
<b>Hairdressing, beauty, personal care</b>	<b>Hairdressing, beauty, personal care:</b> Open. Can remove mask for services. Density quotient of 1 person per 4sqm applies. QR code check-ins are required. Venues can have up to 25 patrons before the density quotient applies.
<b>Hospitality</b>	<b>Food and drink facilities:</b> Open for seated service only with a maximum patron cap of 100 per venue. Group limit of 10. Density quotient of 1 person per 4sqm applies. A venue smaller than 100sqm can have up to 25 people per venue before the density quotient applies. COVID Check-in Marshals must ensure attendees check-in. Dancefloors closed.
	<b>Food courts:</b> Density quotient of 1 person per 4sqm applies. QR codes must be displayed at every table. COVIDSafe Marshals in each food court.
<b>Accommodation</b>	<b>Accommodation:</b> Open. Bookings permitted for single households, intimate partners or single bubbles.
<b>Real Estate Services</b>	<b>Inspections and auctions:</b> Auctions permitted with a maximum patron cap of 100 people indoors or outdoors. Inspections permitted with a private appointment, to a maximum of 10 people, subject to density quotient of 1 person per 4sqm. COVID Check-in Marshals must ensure attendees check-in.
